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I have suggested in the second edition (paperback) of my study of Mahler, *Gustav Mahler: Songs and Symphonies of Life and Death*, 2002, p. 637, that Rosenzweig [Mathis] (1897–1948) ‘should without doubt be recognized as a pioneer of Mahler studies’. His incomplete and unpublished typescript draft, together with an incomplete English translation, may be examined in the Library of the Guildhall School of Music and Drama in London. Copies are also in the possession of the Pierpont Morgan Library, New York, the Bibliothèque musicale Gustav Mahler in Paris, and the International Gustav Mahler Society in Vienna.

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
