

Seznam literatury

Jakýkoli výčet literatury je tak obsáhlý, že je zapotřebí učinit výběr. V Poznámkách lze nalézt přesné odkazy k výňatkům z textu a komentář k jednotlivým dílům. Některé drobnější detaily zde uvedeny nejsou. Zároveň existují práce, které v textu zařazeny nejsou, přesto však by si zasloužily čtenářskou pozornost. V tomto ohledu je můj dluh tak velký, že případný další komentář by byl nadbytečný.

Daný výčet má za cíl poskytnout učitelům a studentům doplňující informaci k příslušným tématům. Pokud by to bylo jen možné, doporučil bych srovnávací přístup k jednotlivým tématům, přestože k některým zemím jsou, pokud jde o národnostní hledisko, uvedeny významné prameny zřídka.

Výčet jednotlivých částí:

1. *Šestnácté století v evropských dějinách*: povšechné prameny přibližující význam šestnáctého století pro moderní evropské dějiny jako celku.
2. *Šestnácté století na úsvitu moderní doby*: práce, které zasazují šestnácté století do kontextu období cca 1400–1800.
3. *Atlasy*: poskytují užitečný úvod a mapy, které značně přispívají k pochopení historických událostí.
4. *Odkazy*: práce, jež mohou poskytnout podrobnější, nebo odlišný pohled na různá témata.
5. *Prameny*: k dispozici je značné množství přeložených podkladů a textů a přístup k základním materiálům historického výzkumu je mnohem jednodušší, než se často předpokládá.
6. *Témata*: práce pokrývající témata běžně spojovaná se šestnáctým stoletím: renesance, reformace, protireformace a zámořské výboje.
7. *Ekonomiky a společnosti*: protože tolik prací, které se týkají určitých regionů nebo námětů, všeobecně odkazuje k Evropě jako celku, sestavil jsem seznam literatury, jež vede ke srovnávacímu přístupu. Čtenář si sám určí, zda je instruktivní srovnání možné.
8. *Dějiny měst*: široký výběr literatury odkazující na význam měst v hospodářském, sociálním, náboženském a politickém životě Evropy šestnáctého století, včetně studií o reformaci ve městech.
9. *Státy a války*: tento výběr podporuje srovnávací přístup, v tomto případě ke srovnávání různých aspektů v postavení jednotlivých států v Evropě.
10. *Regionální studie*: jedná se většinou o knihy zabývající se příslušnými zeměmi v daném období, ale jsou zde rovněž zařazeny texty, jež skýtají podrobnější pohled hlavně na politické skutečnosti.
11. *Sbírky esejů*: zvláštní, že po studentech se často vyžaduje, aby napsali práci, aniž by se seznámili s pracemi historiků. Tento výběr literatury má stimulovat k dalšímu tvůrčímu vyhledávání, seznámení se stylem a stavbou odborných historických prací.

Rozdělení do příslušných kategorií je zde volné. S ohledem na rozsah a čtenářskou trpělivost bylo třeba se vyhnout opakovanému zařazení každého článku ze všech souborů. Doufejme, že přehledné abecední řazení v každé části – spolu s informacemi v Poznámkách – přispěje ke snadnému vyhledání příslušného tématu.
