This Guide is at best suggestive of the exhausting range of resources, primary and secondary, available for further Augustinian study. My own rather modest yet demanding recommendation for an initial serious study of the mind and the heart of Augustine would be to read *The Confessions*, *The City of God*, and *The Trinity*, in the translations of Warner, Dods, and McKenna, respectively, together with Peter Brown's *Augustine of Hippo*. And, when this has been completed, to read them all again.
