

washing their hands, whereas at a nearby hospital without students the doctors do not wash their hands. One inference that we might draw is that the doctors at the first hospital feel obliged to follow their own advice while the students are watching, whereas at the second hospital the watchful eye of students, the physicians allow the students to observe what they do.
