

REFERENCES

THE REFERENCE LIST below has been constructed using an 'author-date' approach as used in the *Migration Atlas*. The initials of the first author have been given priority over date of publication, so that the publications of each individual come together in the list, even if an author has used incomplete initials on their different publications.

For an individual author we have listed single-author references, then any with a second author, and thirdly any with three or more authors. The list then moves to the next individual in the

alphabetised list. Single-author references are alphabetised, first by surname, second by the author's full initials and, third, by date of publication. Two-author references are alphabetised by first author, second author and then date. Where there are three or more authors, references in the text are in the form of 'Author *et al.* year'. So that these references can be quickly located, they are listed by first author and date, with the names of the second and subsequent authors, given lower priority in the alphabetisation process.
