Jonas Kaufmann's "tender lyricism" and "fearless high notes" created a "vocally splendid Faust" in Tony Award winner Des McAnuff's "theatrically daring" 2011 production for the Met (*The New York Times*). Also including the "outstanding" René Pape (*New York Daily News*) and the "daring" Marina Poplavskaya (Financial Times) and supported with "buoyancy and French flair" by star conductor Yannick Nézet-Séguin (Wall Street Journal), McAnuff's atomic-age vision of Gounod's melodrama entertains and compels.
