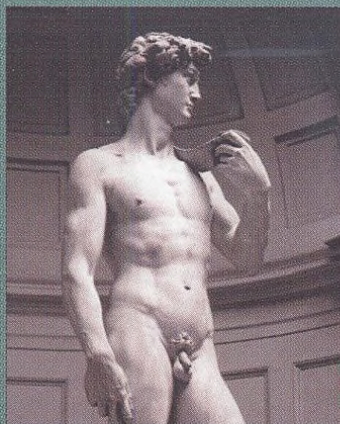


THE TALLIS SCHOLARS RENAISSANCE GIANTS
