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A year ago, in 1964, the first volume of the Prague Bulletin of Mathematical Linguistics was published. It contained two articles: one by Vojtěch Čáka and another by J. Švec and J. Šedivý. Both concerned then non-existent machine translation systems. In 1964, the term "Machine Translation" was still new and exciting, and the present article, although it is now 49 years old, is still much closer to the present day than the other articles.	
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
