



**Mgr. Martin Golec, Ph.D.** is by focus an archaeologist. He works as a Senior Lecturer at the Department of History at Palacký University in Olomouc. Since his studies, which he completed with a doctoral degree at the Institute of Archaeology and Museology of the Faculty of Arts of Masaryk University in Brno, he has concentrated on the Earlier Iron Age – Hallstatt Period in Moravia. Since 2007, he has systematically examined and published outputs with a focus on the important Central European cave locality called Býčí Skála, with special attention to its temple from the Hallstatt Period. He systematically concentrates on the area of the Moravian Karst, where he develops an understanding of the relationship between mankind and cave in the landscape of the Dražanská Vrchovina (Uplands) and its foothills.
