## DON BECK, COVER ARTIST

Don Beck attended Marquette University from 1968 through 1974. Upon graduation in 1974 with a degree in Oral Biology and a certificate in Fixed Prosthodontics, he joined the faculty at the University of the Pacific School of Dentistry in San Francisco, Calif. As a member of the full-time faculty in the Department of Fixed Prosthodontics, he was responsible for teaching clinical dentistry and also teaching preclinical courses in occlusion and dental anatomy. Needing to do visual presentations to supplement these preclinical courses, he found a creative outlet for using a camera, specific lighting, and specialty films. It was during that time that he recognized a strong similarity between photography and prosthodontics. Texture, color,

shape, and reflected light are not only necessary for a successful prothodontic outcome, but are also dominant themes in his photographic images. Currently, he maintains a private practice limited to prosthodontics in San Mateo, Calif.
