

Every pianist and string player cherishes the opportunity to perform Mozart's heavenly piano quartets, and the joy and the challenge of engaging with this music are palpable from the present live recordings. Daniel Barenboim has been familiar with Mozart's music both as a pianist and as a conductor for seven decades. Here he appears as the first among equals with a quartet formation that includes his son, the violinist Michael Barenboim, solo violist with the Berlin Staatskapelle Yulia Deyneka, and cellist Kian Soltani, whose debut album *Home* was also released by Deutsche Grammophon in 2018.

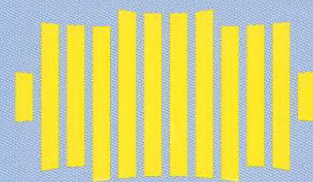
