

Plácido Domingo sings Leoncavallo's rarely performed *May Night*, a beautiful French vocal-symphonic poem based on Alfred de Musset's romantic dialogue between the poet and his muse.

The great tenor is partnered here by conductor Alberto Veronesi — a specialist in this repertoire — and is joined for five of the *Pagliacci* composer's equally neglected French and Italian songs by pianist Lang Lang, making his debut recording as a vocal accompanist.
