Note: The use of a capital letter for a dragonfly's name means it is a *species* of dragonfly (for example, Bluebell Dragonfly). The use of a lower case, or small, letter means that it is a member of a larger *group* of dragonflies. The species names of dragonflies in this book are their common, rather than scientific, names. This means that a dragonfly with a common name in one region may have a different name in another.
