Unit 1 Meeting People

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- Language Study:** Phonetic symbols. Intonation. Present forms of "to be" and "to have", gender, articles, "there is", "there are", singular, plural, imperative mood, adjectives, comparison of adjectives.
- Functions:** Greetings, introductions, farewells.

Unit 2 Talking About Myself. My Family

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- Language Study** Pronouns. Case. Possessive case. Verbs with two objects. More about the Imperative mood. Word order. One, ones.
- Functions** Thanks, essential expressions of agreement and disagreement.

Unit 3 Describing People

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- Language Study** Numerals (fractions, percentages, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division). Time expressions. What time is it? What is the date? The present simple tense. The present continuous tense.
- Functions** Apologies. What do you say if you don't understand? Asking the time.

Unit 4 Jobs, Professions, Career, Employment

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- Language Study** Interrogative pronouns. Wh-questions. Many, much, few, little, a few, a little, how many, how much, more, less. Short answers with "so" and "not". More about articles.
- Functions** Asking for advice / an opinion. Giving advice / an opinion.

Unit 5 Housing

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- Language Study** Giving information about place. Some prepositions of place and direction. Indefinite pronouns "some", "any", "no" + compounds. "None". Indefinite pronouns "another", "other", "the other", "the others", "each other", "one another". Modal verbs in the present tense: "CAN", "MAY", "MUST"
- Functions** A visit. Invitation. Interrupting a conversation.

Unit 6 Shopping

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- Language Study** The future simple tense. The future continuous tense. The conditional "would", "should", "could". The British monetary system.
- Functions** Compliments. Complaints. Requests.

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Functions	Asking the way. Giving directions and locations. Public notices.	
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Language Study	The passive voice. Process verbs describing a change of state. Indefinite pronouns "every", "each", "all", "whole". Comparing things ("like", "as ... as", "so ... as", "the same", "the same as", "than").	
Functions	Weather forecasts. Some ways of considering future events. Warnings.	
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Functions	Making suggestions. Indifference. Not knowing. Saying you are / are not interested.	
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
