The Italian composer Luigi Rossi, a prominent figure in both Italy and France in the 17th century, composed two operas and more than 300 cantatas, most of them unknown today.

His vocal compositions are supremely inventive and richly varied in their expression, often shifting from intense recitative to mellifluous song, while also venturing into daring harmonic regions.

This triple-disc album contains Luigi Rossi's most beautiful arias and includes 21 world-premiere recordings.
