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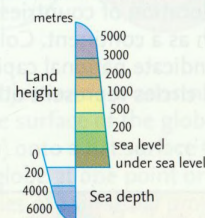
**Map Symbols**

Symbols are used, in the form of points, lines or areas, on maps to show the location of and information about specific features.

The colour and size of a symbol can give an indication of the type of feature and its relative size.

The meaning of map symbols is explained in a key shown on each page. Symbols used on reference maps are shown below.
