Summary

The presented English-Czech, German-Czech and Czech-German-English Dictionary of Sports Terminology has been built on the original publications of the author *Sportovní slovník česko-německý a německo-český anglicko-český slovník sportovních termínů* (Praha, Karolinum, 1979), which has been significantly extended by adding the English language dictionary section.

The dictionary is based on primary English, Czech and German sport-related sources offering a large lexicon of terms relating to sports, sports training and other related domains. The three-language edition includes approximately 2000 main entries, with more than 750 sub-entries. The selection of the terms was carried out in cooperation with experts in the field, taking into account their frequency of use and the practical needs of users.

The dictionary is a comprehensive reference especially for students and teachers of physical education and sport, as well as those who come in contact with foreign exercise science literature sources or other names or authors of scientific papers with a professional or general interest in sports.

The publication represents an open system enabling continuous updating.
