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The second phase will be to analyse your own errors in the subject area of each. Of course, the object of this exercise is to identify errors which you already know (although English grammar errors may surprise you and it can often take you by surprise). So, it is quite sensible to start after chapter 6 - which deals with grammar errors - so that you can more confidently deal with errors by your learners and you can also turn to reflect on your own errors more effectively.
