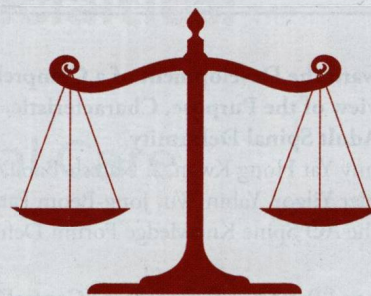

This month's cover shows a strategic map of the German advance into the Soviet Union during WWII, known by the code name Operation Barbarossa. This year is the 80th anniversary of the invasion, during which more forces were committed than any other theater of war in history. The operation included some of the largest battles, most horrific atrocities, and highest casualties in human combat. Many were starved and killed, including 3.3 million Soviet prisoners of war and vast numbers of civilians. The offensive stalled and failed due to cold temperatures, lack of resources, and logistics, contributing to the overall defeat of the Axis powers in WWII. 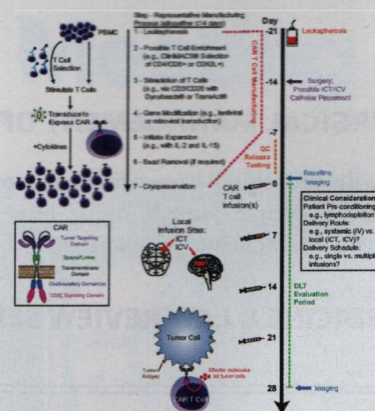

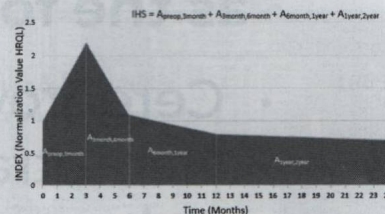
