Marks are calculated so that each paper is worth 40 marks. This gives a total of 200 marks, which can be divided by 2 to give a percentage. The approximate ranges of percentages for each grade are typically as follows: A - 80% and above; B - 75% to 79%; C - 60% to 74%; Failing grades: D - 55% to 59%; E - 54% and below.
