Studentské dialogy / Student Dialogues, founded in October 1893, is the main academic Czech scholarly journal devoted to modern history of Central, Eastern and South-eastern Europe. It has been published by the Institute of History of the Czech Academy of Sciences since 1960. The journal originally focused on the Slavic peoples and their interactions with other ethnic groups and neighbours but has been covering the entire region since the 1960s, including the non-Slavic lands such as Hungary, Romania and the Balkans, as well as Carpathians and (Post)Soviet Central Asia. The contributions are published in English, Czech and Slovak. The journal has especially focused on different forms of mutual interactions, political relations, representations, and cultural transfers among the various peoples of the region. It is currently published twice a year.

At the end of 2021, the new members of *Studentské dialogy / Student Dialogues*, doc. Ladislav Hladký and doc. Radosław Witek, along with managing editor Jan Hl Pucel, passed the magazine with a new editorial team. Professor Hladký, director of the Institute of History of the Czech Academy of Sciences, is replacing the publisher, which has been publishing the journal for the last three decades, created by the position of the editor-in-chief. Dr. David Svoboda, director of the Study of Post-Soviet Regimes, Prague & Museum of the History of the 20th Century, Prague, was named assistant editor-in-chief. Dr. Jitka Škorpová (Director of History of the Czech Academy of Sciences, Brno) is the new managing editor.

The Editorial Board has been redefined as a body composed of scholars from the entire Czech and Slovak research institutions and universities with Czech and Slovak as communication languages. The International Advisory Board has been composed of primarily foreign scholars, with English as a language of communication. I am grateful to new members of both Editorial and Advisory Boards for accepting my invitation and look forward to our future cooperation. I wish to bid farewell to the "old" members of the Editorial Board and Advisory Board for the past years' contribution to our journal.
