Timing	Total: 4 minutes (pair) \ 8 minutes (two) Task 1 – Introductory discussion: 1 minute (pair) \ 2 minutes (two) Task 2 – Long discussion: 3 minutes (pair) \ 4 minutes (two)
Focus	Discussing, exchanging ideas, agreeing and disagreeing, asking for opinions, explaining views, justifying opinions, reaching agreements, making decisions, suggesting ideas, speculating, negotiating, etc.
Interaction	Intehocutor – Candidate – Candidate

Part 3, which also comprises two different tasks, is the main 'individual' part of the exam, although there are some candidate interaction elements. It is important to know that this entire part revolves around one core topic (e.g. Trust). In the first task, one of the candidates is given a card with a question and three prompts. Here is first asked to talk about the topic on the card for about two minutes. When the two minutes are over, a short discussion will begin. The examiner will ask the second candidate a follow-up question and then invite the first candidate to join in for a further two minutes. After approximately one minute, it is the other candidate's turn to be given a card, and the task will begin again.
